Happy Summer! Sunshine and long days! Beaches and ball games! Children's laughter in the neighborhood and ice cream treats! What's not to love about the carefree days of summer?! Our summer sermon series embraces the joy of childhood and the wisdom of the Hundred-Acre-Wood.

In the excerpt above, Winnie-the-Pooh and Piglet have confused themselves as they seek to track a Woozle in the woods. When Christopher Robin points out the truth that none of the mysteriously appearing tracks belong to Woozles, but rather to Winnie and Piglet as they keep circling the same tree trunk, Pooh Bear does what many of us would do, he starts to beat himself up. "I'm no good. I'm stupid."

But Christopher Robin speaks yet another truth in his ear: "You're the Best Bear in All the World!" And Pooh responds, "Am I?" and then he brightens up!

As we look for the Gospel in unexpected places, like a children's book, this story seems to capture the essence of God's good news for us in Jesus. Just when you think you are worthless or foolish, Jesus whispers, I think you are the Best One in All the World!"

It brings to mind a Max Lucado quote, "If God had a refrigerator, your picture would be on it. If He had a wallet, your photo would be in it. He sends you flowers every spring and a sunrise every morning. Face it, friend. He is crazy about you!"

Live in the light of that good news today! **God is crazy about YOU!** And our one job is to make sure everyone knows that God is crazy about them, too! Shine bright, beloved! Love is the way!


