
Dearly Beloved!

Today I am reminiscing about our church. On Sunday, September 17th, I led a memorial service for Olive Getchius' brother, Randy. Olive Getchius and her friend, Wilson Zaring, wrote a spectacular history of Champaign First United Methodist Church. I have mentioned it in sermons and, from time to time, find myself lost in the ministry of people long dead, filled with gratitude for the gift of ministry and mission we have inherited.

There was rapid growth in the early years and the church building grew, too. It began with the original wood frame construction (dedicated in 1863), to the Brick Church (dedicated in 1889), to the final Stone Church, (dedicated in 1907). There was a significant renovation of the Sanctuary in the 1960s changing the exterior and interior to what we see today.

We have some pictures of the old Sanctuary, but not very many. If you were part of the congregation at that time, do you have pictures? Would you please bring them in so that we could make a copy? Perhaps you have wedding, baptism or confirmation photos? Or you know about a stash of pictures hiding somewhere in the building now?

As delighted as I am to see the old pictures of this holy space, I am most interested in the ministries offered by this congregation over the years. Foremost in my mind right now is the commitment of this congregation to start a Child Care Center fifty years ago in 1973.



We will be celebrating this ministry of the church on September 24th in worship. The Child Care Center remains a ministry of the church, not an independent business operation housed in our building. It continues to meet the need for quality childcare in our community with 71 students currently enrolled. The Child Care Center is offering a Fifty Year Celebration on Friday night, September 22, 5:30-7:30 pm...AND YOU ARE ALL INVITED!

We are building our future on the foundation of a strong past dedicated to serving this community. We continue to look for ways to show our love for God by serving our community neighbors. Keep up the good work!




First United Methodist Church (FUMC) AND First United Methodist Child Care Center (FUMCCC)



Attention Soup Cooks and Bakers!



But, if I skipped that awkward in between time, I wouldn't have memories and inside jokes that I treasure now.

The view of the parking garage won't be as nice as the final product, but it's a good reminder for me to appreciate even the awkward, in between parts of change. I can see the growth and the promise of what's to come, while also appreciating things (like the view of a parking garage - I wrote that it was gray, but it's a nice touch that there is a good amount of brickwork!) that I would never even notice otherwise. I hope that I can start appreciating these growing stages by remembering that God has sprinkled things for me to take note of that I would typically not even "see."




