Sunday Morning Markets Coming Soon!



We will offer baked goods—including pies, breads, and coffeecakes—beautiful gift baskets, two varieties of homemade soup sold by the quart, and our Sensational Silent Auction, featuring goods and services provided by members of our congregation! What Can You Do to Help Now?

In the meantime, here's what you, your family, your ministry team, or your Wesley Covenant Group can do to help:

- If you are a baker or a soup maker, please stop at the UWF table in Friendship Center North on September 17 or 24 to let us know what you plan to make (soup recipes provided)
- Begin gathering items to include in a small or medium gift basket focusing on one of these themes: Fall, Christmas, U of I Sports, Senior Citizens (stamps, Word Search, tea), Spa (e.g. shower, bath, relaxation CD), Cooking (e.g. measuring cups, cookbook). We plan to price the baskets between \$15 and \$35, so please keep that in mind as you plan and shop.
- Once you've decided on a theme, gather items and place them in a plastic bag (one bag per gift basket). Leave the bags in the container in the Resource Room no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, September 18. We'll decorate the baskets for you!

The Minds in Motion program is designed to promote healthy aging. Each Minds in Motion activity has been selected for optimal benefit, intended to sustain or improve mental and physical functioning in older adults.

Who can benefit from participating in Minds in Motion?

Any older adult who enjoys interacting with others and wishes to optimize his or her physical and brain functioning.

Older adults with physical limitations such as arthritis, tremors, or balance problems may especially benefit from the activities included in the Minds in Motion program. Any adult with mild memory loss will also benefit from participating.

This Fall, programs will focus on activities that are supported as benefitting brain function, including nutrition, exercise/movement, meditation/relaxation, sleep, music and cognitive therapies, along with outings in the community. Lunch is provided at each session.
