
I did not have help because I did not ask for help. This church family is good to respond and work together on projects; I thought I could do it myself. Lesson learned. Again.

Sometimes, we will be together and both respond to someone speaking to us with the same inside joke at the same time.

We aren't twins, but my brother calls this "twintuition." It's one of those funny moments of just being on almost the exact same mental wavelength as someone else.

What would being on the same mental wavelength as Jesus feel like? It's something that we strive to do as Christians every day! We try to act as Jesus did, love as He did, feel compassion as He did, worship as He did, serve as He did. We are continually trying to align ourselves to Jesus' will.

Additionally, Jesus knows us better than we know ourselves - in that aspect, we are sort of already on a same mental wavelength. He knows us even better than the people who we may have "twintuition" with. Jesus knows when we are about to laugh before we do, what we are about to feel before we feel it, and what we think without us even saying a word. It's the highest form of connection.




Need a Ride to Church on Sunday?




